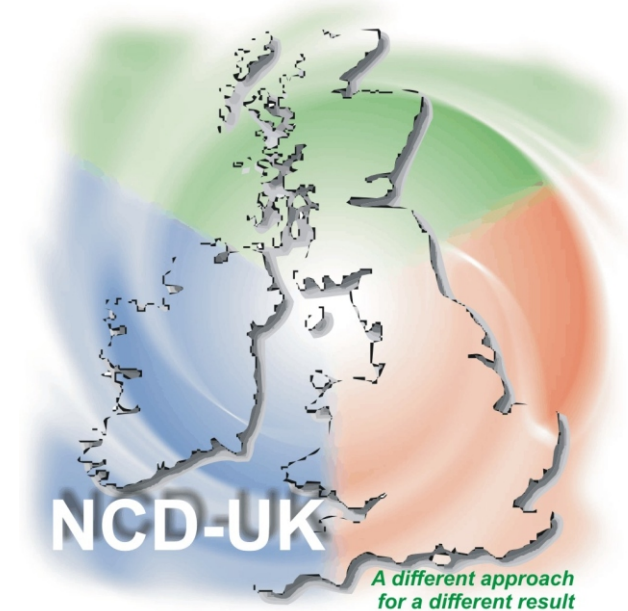

What?

Churches implementing the principles behind Natural Church Development experience an increase in quality and growth as a natural consequence. When working with a coach a church has almost 100% better chances of staying the course and experiencing “all by it self” growth.

Following upon the very popular Coaching I & II workshops, which focused on coaching individuals and teams in general, this workshop will focus entirely on how to coach a church through a NCD process.

The workshop will be a mixture of up-front teaching and many practical exercises where all participants will have ample opportunities to practice what is being taught.
