Welcome to the NCD-UK TCP Seminar 2

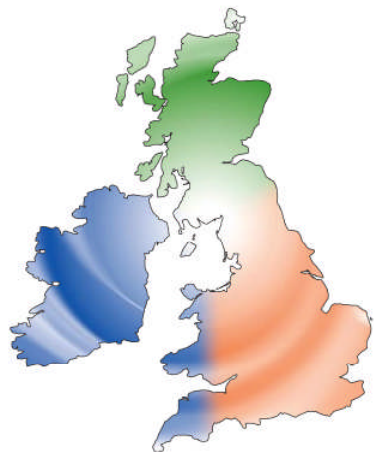

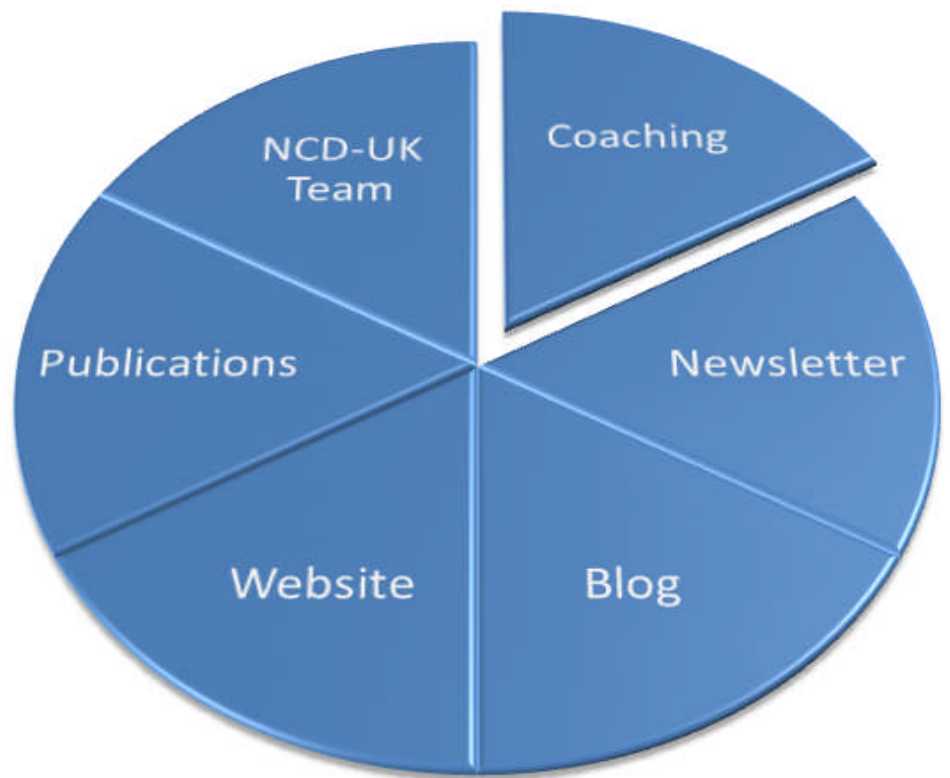
